

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# **INTRODUCTIONS OF PARTS**

#### **FEATURES IN THIS MACHINE ARE:**

#### • RUST FREE


This machine is made of **Hi Impact Polymer Fiber** which is rust free. This gives your machine a longer life.

#### PRE SOAK

Soaking is an important element of the washing process. It enhances and optimizes the detergent's action on the clothes. With this washing machine you can forget about soaking the clothes manually. Just put your clothes in the machine, add water and detergent, the rest will be taken care of by the Unique Auto Soak feature. The Unique Auto Soak option provides you the benefit of an ideal soak, which is better than the manual soak. It supplements soaking with intermittent agitation to ensure that all your clothes receive uniform soaking and better detergent action.

#### UNIQUE SPIN FOUNTAIN

When the washed clothes are transferred into the spin tub, there are chances of the detergent still remaining in the clothes. This washing machine has a special inlet in the spin tub through which water is showered onto your clothes. This ensures that any traces of detergent left on the clothes are removed before drying.



# Parts Identification

#### **CONTROL PANEL**



- Water Inlet : This is used to direct water supply to wash tub for washing or spin tub for spin shower.
- 2. Wash Timer This timer is used for Pre SOAK, WASH and RINSE operations. Following combination can be selected.
  A) Pre Soak + Wash :- Select the desire soak time by setting the Timer between 15-40 min.

B) Wash/Rinse:- You can select any Wash/Rinse time up to 15min. For eg. if you want to Wash/Rinse time for shorter duration turn the knob up to 10min. aposition and turn it back to desired position for normal cycle.


Wash Selector: Set the knob to DELICATE, GENTLE, NORMAL, INTENSE, ULTRA+ according to kinds and quantity of the laundry.

(Number and names of wash Program may differ from model to model)

**4. Drain Selector** : This selector is to set for "WASH/RINSE" or "DRAIN" the water from wash tub.

WASH / RINSE for wash & rinse program. DRAIN for draining the water from the wash tub.

5. Spin Timer : This timer is used to select your desired length of time to spin laundry by using 10minutes timer. (if you want to set the timer to 2 min. or less, turn the selector up to the 10min. position, and then turn it back to the desired position.



Note: 1) Do not rotate the knobs more then prescribed limits.

- 2) Above Graphics is just for representation, it may not match with your machine.
- 3) Refer Specification chart.

# **Safety Precautions**

Do not use Washing Machine to wash items other than Clothes, Blankets, Curtains, Towels, etc.

Never disassemble, Repair or Remodel this washing machine. This can cause fire or irregular action that may Result in injury.


# Consult Brand Service Desk Mentioned on Warranty Terms & Conditions page

- Install the washing machine on a sturdy floor levelled across corners
- If machine is installed on Carpet, be sure that Carpet does not block any openings.
- Do not place flammable substances near the machine such as Kerosene, Benzine, Paint Thinner and Alcohol. Do not put clothing with such substances in the tub. There is a risk of Explosion or Fire.
- When spinning always use the spinning cap pressing tightly against the clothes, maintain the horizontal level.
- Do not use water hotter than 40° C for washing clothes.
- It is recommanded to drain all the water from wash tub if any, after completion of your wash cycle.

- Never touch laundry with your hand during the spin cycle until the tub has completely stopped spinning.
- If you touch the laundry, even if the tub is rotating slowly, there is a danger of injury if your hand becomes entangled with the laundry. pay particular attention to protecting children from such injury.



- When the washing machine gets dirty, wipe it with the slightly wet cloth.
- Do not use machine when power cord is torn or damage Removing the power plug from the power outlet, you should remove it by pulling its plug insulated body, not its cord; and do not place the machine or any heavy objects on the power cord; it may cause the damage to the power cord. If the plug of power cord is damaged, contact your brand authorised service desk (details in last page).



#### NOTE:

"This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance."

## How to Install

- Install the Washing machine in a well-ventilated, safe place. Machine should be put on flat ground and where can you connect the power supply. It is recommended to place the washing machine on a leveled floor and avoid a place where the washing machine can be exposed to direct sunlight.
- 2) Insert the power plug firmly into the main power supply.
- 3) Water supply in the inlet hose can be adjusted to Wash Tub or Spin Tub.
- 4) The feeding water indicator.

When the water spills out of the hole above the label, it means too much water has been supplied. Adjust the water tap.

5) Pull out the drain hose from the washing machine. When using the machine for the first time, you may find water remaining in the drain hose. It was used for the factory performance test. It does not imply any malfunction.





# **Preparation for Washing**

- 1. The machine should be put on Flat Ground.
- 2. Ensure Three Core Power Plug seat must have Ground Connection.
- 3. Lay down the Drain Hose.
- 4. Connect the water Inlet Hose to Water Tap.
- Remove objects like coins, pins, foreign particles, etc., from clothes before washing. They may damage your clothes and clog drain system.
- 6. According to the weight of cloth, adjust the level of water.
- 7. Switch ON power.

#### How to Wash

- 1. Set the knob to "WASH / RINSE".
- 2. Fill the tub with water according to the weight of the cloth (Refer table 1).
- 3. Put the clothes in the tub. Do not put an excessive amount of launcry, in the tub (Refer table 1).
- 4. Put recommendable quantity of detergent as mentioned in Table 1.
- 5. Set the Wash Selector to DELICATE, GENTLE, NORMAL, INTENSE, ULTRA+ mode as you desired.
- Set Wash Time up to 15min, depending on your cloth load & type. For Auto Soaking, set time between 15~40min.
- 7. When washing is completed, drain off the washing water by adjusting the knob to "DRAIN" position.
- 8. After the washing water is discharged, turn the knob switch to "WASH /RINSE" position.
- 9. Fill the water up to the desired level for rinsing.

Note: Water level may be less than the water level line while washing. If so, refill the water. Be careful not to exceed the indicated water level line, it may cause water to spill out of the tub.

Note: 1) Actual quantities of load may vary depending on the material size oflaundry items & hence suggested quantities here are indicative for reference only.

- 2) If movement of cloth is too slow, remove some of the cloth until a steady movement is observed.
- 3) Water Droplets may be seen inside the tub or the outer body when unpacked at customer end; This is neither a Machine Malfunction nor Product has been used earlier.

#### RINSING:

- 1. Fill the water up to desired level depending on cloth load.
- 2. Set WASH TIMER to 5 ~ 15 min. position to RINSE.
- When you finish rinsing, drain off the water from the tub by turning the knob to "DRAIN" position. Transfer clothes to Spin Tub for Spinning.

#### Pre Soak

#### SOAKING FUNCTION:

SOAK Function enhances the efficiency of the regular function, which helps to wash the clothes cleaner. Soak function will be operated after the WASH TIMER switch is set to 40 min position, then the machine will operate with soak function. Soak function will run and stop alternately until the 15th minute then the operation will resume to regular function. To set time for regular wash or soak function, turn the knob to your desired period of time.

# **Spin Shower Rinsing**

With spin shower, the remaining detergent in the clothes will be removed and you can save on additional rinsing time and water. (However, if water from the tap contains rust and / or dirt, do not perform spin shower.)

- 1. Direct water to spin tub by turning knob / lever.
- 2. While SPIN TIMER is at "0" (zero) position (spin tub not rotating), turn on the tap for about 1 minute.
- 3. Turn OFF the tap and then spin for about 2~10 minutes.

# **How to Spin**

- Put the laundry into the spinner tub by putting the small-sized laundry in the bottom area to keep the balance of the tub. (figure 1)
- Place the SPINNER CAP in the tub as shown in the figure 2.
- Close firmly the inner and outer lids of the spinner tub.
- Select the spin time to 2 -10min.


#### SPINNING TIME FOR LAUNDRY

- 1. Cotton clothes: 10min.
- 2. Delicate clothes (Thin synthetic fiber, sarees etc.): 2 min.
- 3. Sweater (Synthetic fiber): 2 ~ 3 min.
- 4. Underwear (Knitting clothes): 3 ~ 5 min.
- 5. Heavy Clothes (Bed Sheet, Towel etc.):10min.

#### HINTS FOR SPINNING

- // If there is a sound from the spinner, open the spinner lid then try to distribute the laundry evenly.
- // If the lid is open while the spinning function is working, the machine will stop within  $5 \sim 10$  seconds. If it is still running, contact Brand service desk.

#### **Care and Maintenance**

Be sure to remove the power plug from main power supply before cleaning the machine and filter

- A) Cleaning MAGIC FILTER
- 1. Push the upper part of the Magic filter and pull in.



2. Open the cover as shown in figure



- 3. Clean the Magic Filter
- Close the cover and insert the lower 'A' part of the filter in the basket first and push the filter from upper part 'B' with "click" sound.



Note: It is recommended to clean the Magic Filter regularly.

#### Cleaning the Wash Tub

- After washing is complete, fill fresh water above the level of pulsator without adding clothes.
- 2. Run the machine for 1~2 minutes turn the knob to "DRAIN" position when pulsator is still rotating.
- 3. When water is completely drained out, turn the knob to "WASH/RINSE" position.
- 4. Finally turn off the machine.

## **Trouble Shooting**



The washing machine does not work.	Is the power supply cord connected to a power outlet?     Is there power cut?     Is the pulsator tangled with something?
Unable to drain	Has the Drain Hose been lowered?     Is the Drain Hose blocked?     Is the Drain Hose kinked?
Abnormal sound during wash.	Are there any loose articles in the Wash Tub?
Incomplete spinning (Severe vibration or unbalance)	Are the laundry arranged evenly? Is the machine being placed on a flat and solid ground? Are there any clothes dangling on the Spin Tub? Are there too many laundry in the Spin Tub? See "Spinning" on page 5

#### **WARRANTY**

Standard Warranty period

2 vears

For S85GS, S85GS1, S95GS, S95GS1 For S85GS2, S95GS2, S85GS3, S95GS3 Warranty Period (applicable only on the parts mentioned below)

5 years (only on wash motor) 10 years (only on wash motor)

#### Customer Privileges.

- 1. The warranty is confirmed only to the first purchase of the appliance and is non-transferable. This warranty card and purchase bill shall be presented to our staff at the time of service and the warranty shall be void if the warranty card is altered/tampered with or lost.
- 2. The warranty period (both standard Warranty Period and Extended Warranty Period) starts from the date of purchase of the appliance and shall be available to products installed within municipal limits.
- 3. The warranty covers only manufacturing defect in material that may arise despite normal operation and usage of the appliance in accordance with the user manual.
- 4. Repairs, installations & removal of the appliance shall be got carried out only by an Authorized Service Personnel, failing which warranty will be void.
- 5. In the event of change of address and contact details, the new address and the new contact details shall be intimated to the Authorised Service Center on the given toll free number for ensuring proper installation, Charges shall be applicable and borne and paid by customer.
- Repairs &/or replacement of parts covered under warranty would be purely at the sole discretion of the Company & Authorised Service centre Head only.
- In the event of a part covered under warranty / wash motor required to be repaired then our person's obligation will be to repair such part/ wash motor to restore the product to working condition.
- 8. The company's obligation in respect of parts covered under warranty in event where repair is not possible shall be to provide replacement of defective parts with a functionally working part / wash motor of any brand/make.
- 9. It is hereby clarified that on expiry of Standard Warranty Period, visiting charges will be applicable for all visits and the same will be borne by the customer. In the Extended warranty period, in case the product needs to be transported to the Authorised Service Center for repair, the transportation charges from and to the place of installation shall be borne and paid by the customer.
- 10. The customer shall provide a reasonable, sufficient and safe working space to access the appliance for service. The customer is liable to move away all blocking objects or move the appliance to an appropriate location with electricity /gas/water supply and drainage for testing of the appliance.
- 11. In case of appliance requires to be repaired at service centre, all expenses incurred in transportation of the appliance or parts thereof from and to the company's Authorised Service Center, as well as expenses incurred on deputing of service personnel/technician towards conveyance, inspection and other incidental expenses, will borne and paid by the customer.
- 12. In case of repairs the replaced spare part will be warranted only for the unexpired period of the warranty.
- 13. The company shall be under no obligation or deemed to be in default or liable for cost, compensation, damage, penalty, fine, or otherwise on account of delay or failure in performance resulting from causes beyond its reasonable control (e.g. strikes, floods, earthquakes etc.) including but not limited to delay in servicing due to non-availability of spare parts and/or accessories.
- 14. The defective part shall belong to the company.
- 15. Warranty issued is subject to purchase from authorized dealers and repair by company's authorized service centre only .
- 16. Dispute if any in respect of Warranty shall be subject to exclusive jurisdiction of Mumbai court irrespective of the point of sale

Warranty is not applicable in any of the following cases:

- 1. If the warranty card is not duly filled and does not bear the stamp, date and signature of the authorized Dealer.
- 2. The warranty does not cover any consequential or resulting liability, damage or loss to property or life arising directly or indirectly as a result of appliance failure, breakdown, or accident or usage of the Appliance not in accordance with the operating / user manual.
- 3. Warranty is not applicable on plastic parts, electrical parts, top, lid, assembly, control panel, window, knobs, nut, bolts, drain pipe, cabinet, dispenser assembly, drain hose, filter, castors, wheels, foot, drum, body of the washing machine and washer. The warranty does not cover consumables, normal wear & tear parts, plastic, glass and/or rubber parts, operational parts and accessories.
- 4. If the Appliance has been subjected to improper use such as operated on trolley other that the one, if any purchased from the Company, use contrary to user manual, misused, abused, not cared for, abnormal use, use of sea water, sub-standard detergent, exposure to dampness, excessive heat, excessive humidity and other extreme environmental conditions, corrosion, damage beyond repair, rusting, unathorised modifications, unauthorized repairs, neglect, accident, damage in transit, alteration, acts of God, spillage of liquid or food particles, faulty electric wiring/cabling, abnormal voltage/power supply beyond appliance specifications, damage/breakage/non-functioning of appliance due to rodents, rats, cockroaches and ants etc.
- 5. The warranty does not cover preventive checks, routine maintenance, cleaning, de-scaling and overhaul and charges shall be borne and paid by Customer.
- 6. If the Appliance is used by commercial establishment including but not limited to hospitals, saloon, institutions, laundry, community hall and other similar establishment or by an individual/ firm for commercial purpose.
- 7. If the warranty card, bill of purchase, serial number of appliance is removed, altered, defaced, made illegal/tampered with. No Person including the customer, dealer, service personal shall have the right to vary the terms of this warranty.
- 8. If incorrect/not suitable detergents are used for laundry appliances.
- 9. If repair, installation work is carried out by persons other that Authorised Service Personnel.
- 10. Damage to the appliance or any part(s) due to transportation or shifting or arising out of improper storage of the appliance at the Customer's premises.
