

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
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
INSTALLATION

Notes:

- Be sure to re-route the hose so that it is not kinked or has sharp bends which will prevent proper drainage.
- The level of the drain hose should be slightly lower than the lowest part
 of the washing machine in order to ensure proper and complete
 drainage.







Connecting the power plug

- Insert the power plug into the outlet.
- If AC outlet with ground terminal is used, grounding is not needed. If not, never forget earthing (earthing method as below).



Connecting the earth wire

- * WARNING: THIS APPLIANCE MUST BE EARTHED.
- Install the earth wire to prevent short-circuit due to leaking current and electric shock,
- It is attached at the back of the washer. Connect it to the metal pipe. If the water pipe is made of plastic, it does not have the earth effect.
- Never connect the earth wire to the gas pipe, lighting arrester, telephone connector, etc.



PREPARATIONS BEFORE WASHING

Preparation

- 1. Attach Inlet Hose to water inlet and other end to a tap.
- 2. Connect power plug.
- 3. Always keep Drain Hose on the ground.

Remember the following:

- Do not wash any clothing that has the instruction "Dry clean only".
- Remove loose articles from pockets of clothing.

PARTS IDENTIFICATION

Control panel



1. Wash Selector

Select "NORMAL" for delicate clothes, select "HEAVY" for Heavy clothes and select "DRAIN" to drain the water from the tub.

2. Water Supply Inlet

Connect the inlet hose from the water tap to feed water to the tub.

3. Wash Timer

Select the desired time for washing.

Do not rotate the knob anticlockwise. Rotate the knob in clock wise direction as indicated by arrow & upto the Red Marking.

PREPARATIONS BEFORE WASHING

Before Washing

- 1. Check the washing instructions labels on the clothing to be washed.
- Remove any objects from the pockets of the clothing. Object left in the pockets may damage the clothing or washing machine (especially cause clogging of the drain hose).
- 3. After separating oiled and dyed laundry, begin washing.







HOW TO WASH

- 1. Set WASH SELECT OR to NORMAL or HEAVY(according to type of laundry).
- 2. Attach inlet hose on top of panel and supply water.
- 3. Add detergent according to Table 2(page 6) and allow it to disperse well.
- Put in clothes and add water upto desired water level.
 Set WASH SELECT OR to HEAVY, NORMAL and set the WASH TIMER as shown in Table 2 (Page 6).
- 6. When washing is over, set WASH SELECT OR to DRAIN.
- 7. After water is drained, set WASH SELECT OR to NORMAL or HEAVY as desired.
